

# NOMINATION FOR 2022 LIFELONG LEARNING AWARD

The annual Lifelong Learning Award honors University of Washington faculty (full- or part-time) who have taught or designed courses, seminars or workshops aimed at nonmatriculated working adults and other nontraditional students, and who have received excellent teaching evaluations for that work.

## DISTINGUISHED CONTRIBUTION TO LIFELONG LEARNING

This award is the highest recognition for UW faculty who make significant contributions to lifelong learning at the UW and carries a \$5,000 stipend.

## ELIGIBILITY

Nominees must have been engaged for at least two years in UW-sponsored outreach programs for professional development, personal interest, or career re-direction and serve in a teaching and/or program development role. Faculty from all three UW campuses are eligible.

## CRITERIA

Nominees should exemplify the following:

- Dedication to lifelong learning activities
- Innovation in lifelong learning
- Impact of their work on the broader regional community
